On Tuesday, August 3, 2011, neighborhoods throughout Flint Township are being invited to join forces with thousands of communities and community partners nationwide for the “28th Anniversary of National Night Out” (NNO) crime and drug prevention event. National Night Out, which is sponsored by the National Association of Town Watch (N.A.T.W.).
